2022 Outcomes

New Phoebe House offers a comprehensive, 4-phased approach to address mental health challenges, substance abuse issues, family reunification, and skill building with each mother in our care. This proven approach empowers our clients to sustain a healthy and productive lifestyle in the community while moving herself and her child(ren) into permanent housing.

In 2022 we celebrated 20 years in the community! We jumped over the hurdles through COVID, and returned to our services to the woman and children we housed. We continued into our aftercare programs having 6 Moms making progress towards custody, 7 opening bank accounts, 7 receiving employment, and 4 working towards employment, 9 women received their license while 8 obtained their own vehicles, and 8 women were actively in their recovery.

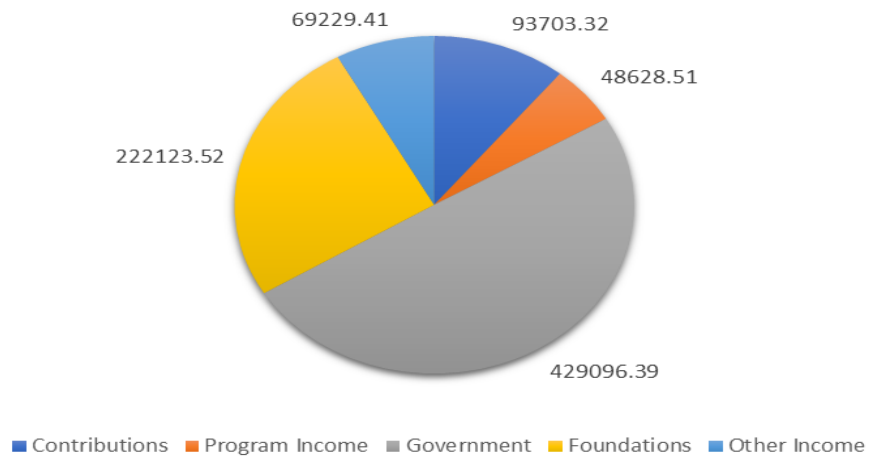
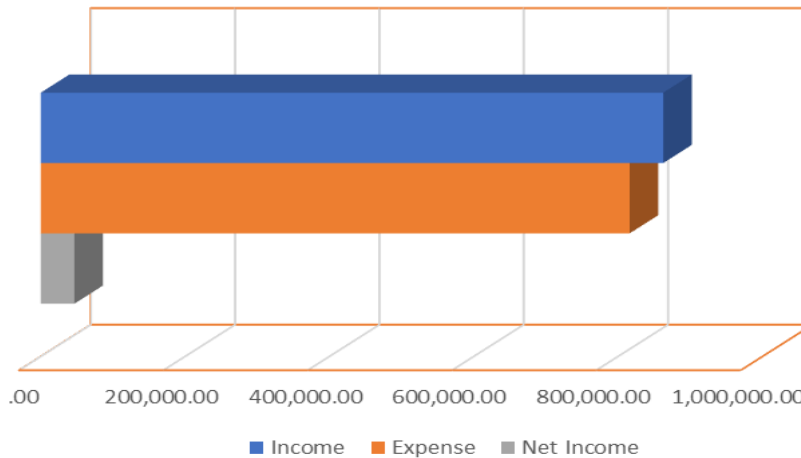
